## POLIN

May sees the launch of an exciting new park on the Mediterranean coast near Antalya, Turkey. The Maxx Royal Resort and Waterpark covers 400,000sq m (131,2335sq ft), with the waterpark accounting for 10,000sq m (107,640sq ft).

Turkish company Polin has designed a mix of rides suitable for the whole family, including 10 waterslides and a -sized water play area with themed slides, fountains and a water play structure. This is

the first site of the eagerly anticipated King Cobra, which Polin unveiled at IAAPA Asia.

King Cobra is the star attraction with Polin's marketing manager, Sohret Pakla, saying it offers an intense riding experience with great visual impact and spectator appeal. "The core feature is the unique configuration which enables two double tubes to race through a circular path, providing twists, turns, and surprises," she says. "Riders experience a steep drop,

then the two tubes speed into the valley section alongside one another."

Polin uses a closed moulded production technology, Resin Transfer Moulding (RTM), which has less styrene emission than open moulded methods and creates less physical waste during production. ●
