## Polin adds more racing fun

A VARIETY of new products and projects ensured a busy four days on the booth of Polin Waterparks and Pool Systems.

The recently introduced King Cobra slide was at the centre of attention, with visitors to the stand agreeing it was a unique attraction in terms of design and being the world's first circular racer tubing slide.

"They all agreed it's been a while since a slide with such massive visual impact has been introduced," said Polin's Sohret Pakis.

The company also introduced its Racer Twin Turbolance at the IAAPA Expo, the second ride in the patented Racer Series. This features circular racing tube slides and a unique entrance design consisting of two double tubes configured side by side along a circular path, in just one mould, as opposed to two slides connected to each other.

"Compared to mat racing slides the difference with our Racer TT is that it does not have a straight path but curves, turns, etc.," explained Pakis. "It can only be used with tubes and is available in fully open, semi closed and fully closed versions, which makes it a perfect racer waterslide option for indoor waterparks."

Polin's booth also featured examples of its resin transfer moulding (RTM) waterslides, showing its natural light effects and special pattern effects, while the company also demonstrated its translucent RTM waterslide components and the new 4D Splashcinema developed in conjunction with Kraftwerk for use in waterparks (see Innovations in Entertainment feature in this issue of *IP* for more details).
