PHUKET AQUAPARK



Thailand's largest island and tourist stronghold will have its first water park soon. 17 water slides and other wet attractions will be erected on an area of 65,000 m² in Patong Beach on the west coast of Kathu. All the slides have been contracted to the Turkish manufacturer Polin, and almost all slides have been completed with the "Resin Transfer Moulding" technology, which makes the attractions unusually smooth and shiny.

Investor in the Phuket Aquapark is Istvan Kuti from Hungary who resides in Thailand, whilst the project management has been transferred to the Hungarian company Eleven KFT Hungary. Responsibility for the design of the 25 million \$ park and the project concept for 3,000 daily guests is in the hands of Zeynep Canbaz from Polin. From the middle of the year, all slide parts will be shipped in a total of 40 containers, so that nothing stands in the way of the envisioned opening at the end of 2010. The admittance price is estimated to be around 14 €.
